12 Court (Dckt. No. 12);

13 WHEREAS, service having been completed and the answer period having elapsed without  
14 an answer or other responsive pleading filed with the Court, Plaintiffs requested that the Court  
15 enter default on July 6, 2015 (Dckt. No. 13);

17 WHEREAS, on July 7, 2015, default was entered against Defendant (Dckt. No. 14);

19 Court of Plaintiffs' intent to file a Motion for Default Judgment (Dckt. No. 15);


