19		alleges he and his brother witnessed a fight near his car, when someone hit Plaintiff in the
20		front of his neck. Plaintiff fell, and his brother intervened to help him. Defendant Officer Ettare arrested Plaintiff and his brother, during which he slammed Plaintiff against the
21		passenger side mirror, breaking it. Plaintiff was transported to the Berkeley Police Department jail. There, Plaintiff was taken to a safety cell, where officers proceed to beat
22		him, breaking his ankle and causing him to lose consciousness. Plaintiff was later transported to Alta Bates Hospital after complaining of an ankle injury. Defendants allege
23		that Officer Ettare was dispatched to the scene after reports of a fight, and that he saw
24		Plaintiff in the middle of the road. Officer Ettare witnessed a vehicle, later identified as Plaintiff's vehicle being driven by Plaintiff's brother, hit Plaintiff's left arm, causing the
25		mirror to fall off. Officer Ettare arrested Plaintiff on suspicion of being drunk in public. Plaintiff was taken to the Berkeley Police Department jail, where he was verbally abusive
26		and combative. Plaintiff was placed in a safety cell, and Defendants deny beating Plaintiff. When Plaintiff complained of an ankle injury, he was taken to Alta Bates Hospital.
