Plaintiff is hereby DIRECTED to advise the 18 Court, no later than July 27, 2015, as to whether she consents to have a magistrate judge conduct all 19 further proceedings in the instant action.<sup>1</sup> For the parties' convenience, consent forms are available 20 at http://www.cand.uscourts.gov, in the "Forms" section.
