**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**



11 On February 21, 2017, the Court held a case management conference, where Defendants  
12 Larry Clarke, Jerrimy Farris, and Open Door Marketing, LLC ("Open Door") did not appear. The  
13 Court then issued an order to show cause, requiring Defendants Clarke, Farris, and Open Door to  
14 explain, by March 10, 2017, why they should not pay monetary sanctions in the amount of \$500  
15 for their failure to appear at the case management conference. (Dkt. No. 138.) As of the date of  
16 this order, Defendants Clarke, Farris, and Open Door have not filed a response.

17 On March 30, 2017, the Court held another case management conference. (Dkt. No. 164.)  
18 Again, Defendants Clarke, Farris, and Open Door did not appear. (*See id.*) Accordingly,  
19 Defendants Clarke and Farris are ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE, in writing, by no later than  
20 **April 27, 2017**, why they should not pay monetary sanctions in the amount of \$500 for their  
21 repeated failure to appear at the case management conferences. All three Defendants are also  
22 ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE, in writing, by no later than **April 27, 2017**, why the Court  
23 should not enter default against Defendants Clarke, Farris, and Open Door for failure to defend in  
24 the instant case.
