1 **PROPOSED ORDER**

2 Pursuant to the stipulation submitted to this Court by plaintiff Nora Salamanca (“Plaintiff”)
3 and defendant Sprint/United Management Company (“Defendant” or “Sprint”) (collectively, the
4 “Parties”) on June 6, 2016, the Court, finding good cause therefor, hereby **ORDERS** as follows:


5 1. All proceedings in this case (including all obligations to respond to discovery, to
6 exchange initial disclosures, or to make any other pretrial filing or exchange of information required
7 under the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure or this Court’s local rules) are hereby **STAYED** until
8 after the completion of the Parties’ mediation, scheduled for July 27, 2016.

9 2. The post-mediation status conference set for June 17, 2016 is vacated and a post-
10 mediation status conference is hereby set for August 12, 2016 at 11:00^{a.m.}, ~~2016~~. If the Parties settle
11 some or all of this matter before that date, they shall promptly notify the Court. ~~If the Parties’~~
12 in a manner that complies with the Civil Local Rules. If the Parties’
13 mediation efforts are unsuccessful, they shall submit an updated case management statement in
14 advance of the post-mediation status conference, and no later than August 5, 2016.

15 The post-mediation status conference statement shall advise the Court of the status of *Viet Bui v.*
16 *Sprint Corporation, a Sprint Communications Company, L.P., et al*, No. 2:14-02461-TLN-AC (E.D.
17 Cal.) (“*Bui*”) and *Olivia Guilbaud v. Sprint Nextel Corporation et al.*, No. 3:13-cv-04357-VC (N.D.
18 Cal.) (“*Guilbaud*”); make recommendations to the Court about whether to lift the stay; the timing,
19 the form and requirement of initial disclosures, and the setting of a trial and pretrial schedule; and
20 discuss any other matters required by the *Standing Order for All Judges of the Northern District of*
California: Contents of Joint Case Management Statement (available on the Court’s website).
