15	Magistrate Judge Corley issued a Report and Recommendation to remand the case. (Dkt. No. 6.)	
16	The Court has reviewed Magistrate Judge Corley's Report and Recommendation	
17	recommending remand of this action to the California state courts for lack of subject matter	
18	jurisdiction. (Dkt. No. 6.) No party has filed an objection to the Report. The Court finds the	
19	Report correct, well-reasoned, and thorough, and adopts it in every respect.	
20	Accordingly, and for the reasons set forth in the Report, the above-captioned action is	
21	REMANDED to the Superior Court of California for the County of San Mateo forthwith, and close	
22	the action.	
23	This Order terminates Docket Number 6.
