## Order Adopting Magistrate Judge's REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION; <br> Remanding Case for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction

This case was removed by defendant from the San Mateo County Superior Court on April 1, 2016. (Dkt. No. 1.)
