
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Plaintiff Christopher Seldon filed his complaint in this action on May 5, 2016. On October 12, 2016, Plaintiff filed an administrative motion to enforce General Order 56 and compel a full site inspection of St. Mary's Medical Center. (Dkt. No. 15.) On November 2, 2016, the Court denied Plaintiff's administrative motion to compel a full site inspection, and ordered the parties to complete an inspection of the relevant portions of the premises within 45 days. (Dkt. No. 17 at 2-3.) Pursuant to General Order 56, Plaintiff's notice of mediation was then due within 42 days of the joint site inspection.¹

As of the filing of this order, Plaintiff has not filed any such notice or moved for administrative relief from that deadline. Accordingly, Plaintiff shall show cause why this case should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. Plaintiff shall file a written response to this order to show cause within 14 days.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
