**ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR
RECONSIDERATION**

13 On December 20, 2016, the Court dismissed Plaintiff Jeremiah W. Balik's purported
14 discrimination action with prejudice and entered judgment in favor of Defendants. Dkt. Nos. 71,
15 72. Plaintiff appealed to the Ninth Circuit the next day. Dkt. No. 73. In response to a notice of
16 referral from the Ninth Circuit, the Court issued an order revoking Plaintiff's *in forma pauperis*
17 status. Dkt. No. 75. The Ninth Circuit later dismissed the appeal as frivolous under 28 U.S.C.
18 § 1915(e)(2). See Dkt. No. 78. Plaintiff then filed a "Motion for IFP Reconsideration" with this
19 Court on May 1, 2017. Dkt. No. 79. Because this motion is not properly before the Court, the
20 Court DENIES the motion. The Court reminds Plaintiff that the Court dismissed this action with
21 prejudice and entered judgment in favor of Defendants. Dkt. Nos. 71, 72. The case is now closed
22 and no further filings will be accepted.
