ORDER OF DISMISSAL

12 On May 17, 2017, the court ordered plaintiffs to show cause why the court should
13 not dismiss this case against the remaining defendants for failure to prosecute. Dkt. 72.
14 Although the parties have filed voluntary or stipulated dismissals as to former defendants
15 Commerce Bancshares, Bank of America, Chase, Experian, and Asset Acceptance LLC,
16 see Dkt. 54, 65, 69, 71, 74, Equifax, Inc. remains as a defendant.

17 Plaintiffs did not respond to the order to show cause by the deadline (May 31), and
18 never filed an amended complaint, which was due by April 10, 2017. Dkt. 66 at 21.

19 Accordingly, the court hereby DISMISSES this case for failure to prosecute
20 pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b). The clerk shall close the file.
