13	On November 29, 2016, the Court entered an order directing
14	Plaintiffs to show cause why this employment discrimination case
15	should not be dismissed for failure to state a claim. 1 Any
16	response to that order was due by December 20, 2016. On December
17	6, 2016, the Court received various documents from cases in
18	several different courts, most involving parties not named in the
19	instant case, with the case number for this case handwritten at
20	the top. Docket No. 4. To the extent Plaintiffs intend for those
21	documents to serve as a response to the order to show cause, they
22	fail to identify any legal basis for their claims or to allege
23	"sufficent factual matter, accepted as true, to state a claim to
24	relief that is plausible on its face." <u>Ashcroft v. Iqbal</u> , 556

1	U.S. 662, 678 (2009). Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed for
2	failure to state a claim. The dismissal is without leave to
3	amend. The Clerk of Court shall enter judgment.
