ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On April 25, 2017, plaintiff Vikki Ordonez filed an amended complaint against Equifax, Inc. ("Equifax") and JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. ("Chase"). Dkt. 17. Ordonez subsequently filed a notice of settlement with Chase, who was voluntarily dismissed as a defendant. Dkt. 23, 29. However, Equifax remains as a defendant in this case.

The parties stipulated that Equifax need not file a response to the amended complaint until June 15, 2017. Dkt. 26. However, more than a month later, Equifax still has not filed an answer, a motion to dismiss, or another stipulation to extend the time to respond. Plaintiff has not filed a motion for an entry of default.

In light of the foregoing, the court hereby ORDERS Equifax to SHOW CAUSE **by August 7, 2017** why a default should not be entered due to its failure to timely respond to the complaint.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
