For example, Plaintiff has yet to serve the summons and complaint, even though the 15 court reminded him of the service requirements set forth in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m). [Docket No. 12]. Additionally, Plaintiff has twice failed to submit the required Case Management 16 Conference Statement. [Docket Nos. 11, 12]. Plaintiff also failed to appear at the July 5, 2017 17 18 Initial Case Management Conference. [Docket No. 13]. 19 In light of the above, the court ORDERS Plaintiff to respond in writing by July 13, 2017 20 and explain why his case should not be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute.
