2	sequential evaluation process and with the assistance of the vocational expert determine what jobs exist,
3	if any, for Plaintiff given her age, education, vocational factors and residual functional capacity.
4	The parties further request that the Clerk of the Court be directed to enter a final judgment in
5	favor of Plaintiff, and against Defendant, reversing the final decision of the Commissioner.
