1 The parties to the above-entitled action jointly submit this NOTICE RE STATUS OF
2 FINAL APPROVAL IN RELATED CASE.

3 WHEREAS on May 4, 2016, four former employees of Defendant, Kevin Chatfield,
4 Geoffrey McBride, Allison Olsen, and Eric Williams, filed a putative class action against
5 *Chatfield et al. v. Revel Systems, Inc.*, San Francisco Superior Court Case No. CGC-16-551802.

6 WHEREAS the parties in the *Chatfield* case have filed a Joint Stipulation of Class Action
7 Settlement and Release.

8 WHEREAS at the Initial Case Management Conference for the instant case, this Court
9 requested that the parties advise of the status of the Final Approval in *Chatfield*.

10 WHEREAS San Francisco Superior Court Judge Curtis E.A. Karnow granted preliminary
11 approval of the settlement and issued an Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Class Action
12 Settlement on May 2, 2017.

13 WHEREAS the Final Approval hearing in *Chatfield* occurred on September 7, 2017, and
14 no class members appeared at this hearing to object to the settlement.

15 WHEREAS Judge Karnow did not issue an Order finally approving the settlement at the
16 time of the hearing, but Defendant anticipates that the settlement will be approved.

17 WHEREAS Judge Karnow set a conference call for September 14, 2017 at 3:30 p.m. to
18 discuss final approval of the settlement.

19 WHEREAS Plaintiff's Motion for Conditional Certification ("Motion") in *Bisaccia* is set
20 for hearing on September 14, 2017 at 2 p.m.

21 WHEREAS to facilitate negotiations on a stipulation to resolve Plaintiff's Motion, the
22 parties have agreed to toll the Fair Labor Standards Act ("FLSA") statute of limitations for the
23 *Bisaccia* proposed collective group and jointly request that the hearing on the Motion be
24 continued.

25 NOW THEREFORE, for good and sufficient consideration, the receipt of which is
26 hereby acknowledged, Plaintiff and Defendant STIPULATE and AGREE as follows:

27 The parties jointly request that the hearing on the Motion be continued to a date
28 convenient to the Court on or after September 28, 2017.
