Pursuant to Rule 4(m) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiff has 90 days to complete service of the complaint and summons 14 15 on Defendant, such that June 4, 2018 was the last day to complete service or to file a Motion for Administrative Relief from the deadline pursuant to Civil L.R. 7-11. The Case Management 16 Conference (CMC), originally scheduled for June 5, 2018, was continued to August 14, 2018, 17 18 because Defendant had not been served 7 days prior to the original CMC date. (Dkt.
