26 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the undersigned counsel
 27 and pursuant to Civil Local Rule 6-2(a), through their undersigned counsel hereby stipulate and
 28 respectfully request the Court to enlarge the time for Plaintiff Alfasigma USA, Inc. to respond to

1 Defendant First Databank, Inc.’s Special Motion to Strike, Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. No. 48) by 14
2 days to and including October 24, 2019. The parties declare in support of this request:

3 WHEREAS, on November 15, 2018, Plaintiff Alfasigma USA, Inc. (“Plaintiff” or
4 “Alfasigma”) filed its Original Complaint (Dkt. No. 1) with Jury Demand against Defendant First
5 Databank, Inc. (“Defendant” or “First Databank”).

6 WHEREAS, on December 21, 2018, First Databank filed its (first) Special Motion to
7 Strike, Motion to Dismiss, and Motion to Strike (“Motion to Dismiss”) (Dkt. No. 18).

8 WHEREAS, on January 2, 2019, Alfasigma and First Databank (together, the “Parties”)
9 stipulated that the time for Plaintiff to file its response to Defendant’s Motion to Dismiss was
10 extended twenty-eight (28) days to and including February 1, 2019. Dkt. No. 19.

11 WHEREAS, on February 1, 2019, Plaintiff filed its response to Defendant’s Motion to
12 Dismiss. Dkt. No. 26.

13 WHEREAS, on August 2, 2019, the Court entered its order denying Defendant’s Special
14 Motion to Strike and Motion to Strike, and granting in part and denying in part Defendant’s
15 Motion to Dismiss. Dkt. No. 41.

16 WHEREAS, on August 14, 2019, the Parties stipulated that First Databank may file an
17 answer to the complaint up to and including August 28, 2019. Dkt. No. 42.

18 WHEREAS, on August 29, 2019, Alfasigma filed its First Amended Complaint. Dkt. No.
19 46.

20 WHEREAS, on September 26, 2019, First Databank filed its Special Motion to Strike and
21 Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs’ Amended Complaint. Dkt. No. 48. Pursuant to Local Rule 7-3(a),
22 Plaintiff’s response to the motion is due within fourteen (14) days after service. Plaintiff’s
23 response to the motion is currently due on October 10, 2019.

24 IT IS SO STIPULATED AND AGREED, subject to Court approval, that Plaintiff’s
25 response to Defendant’s Special Motion to Strike, Motion to Dismiss shall be filed on or before
26 October 24, 2019.
