**ORDER RESCINDING COERCIVE
SANCTIONS**

11 As stated by both Parties' counsel on the record at a follow-up sanctions hearing on
12 January 11, 2022, the Parties have now resolved their outstanding disputes concerning
13 Defendant's compliance with the court's discovery order of November 2, 2021 (dkt. 33)
14 ("Discovery Order"). Additionally, the court will note that on January 11, 2022, Defendant filed a
15 certification of full compliance with the Discovery Order. Because coercive sanctions are no
16 longer necessary, the court herewith **RESCINDS** the provisions of its previously-issued sanctions
17 order (dkt. 57) ("Sanctions Order") imposing certain fines on Defendant and it is **ORDERED** that
18 Defendant is relieved of any obligation to pay the sanctions amounts set forth in the Sanctions
19 Order. Further, as set forth in detail on the record at the follow-up sanctions hearing, the Parties
20 are **ORDERED** to jointly-file a Notice on the court's docket no later than the close of business on
21 Friday, January 14, 2022, clearly setting forth that the process of fact discovery in this case has
22 now been completed.
