 20 respond to the complaint pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 6(b).

21 WHEREAS the complaint was filed on November 16, 2021;

22 WHEREAS the parties previously agreed to extend the time by which a responsive
 23 pleading must be filed to January 10, 2022, and the Court entered an Order to that effect;

24 WHEREAS the parties have engaged in settlement discussions which are ongoing and
 25 believe it is in both parties’ interest to continue to explore an early resolution through these
 26 discussions rather than spending resources litigating the matter;
