20 Plaintiff filed this action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) of the Social
21 Security Act for judicial review of a final decision of the Commissioner of Social
22 Security, denying her application for benefits. On August 14, 1996, this Court
23 entered an order remanding this case pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), sentence six
24 for further administrative proceedings to consider new and material evidence. On
25 remand, in a decision dated February 6, 1997, the Commissioner issued a partially
26 favorable decision awarding Plaintiff benefits.


