2	(2) the \$23,500 in trust funds held by Defendants' counsel, Gary Varga, shall be applied to the receivership fees and expenses previously approved by the Court ² ;		
3 4	(3) all remaining outstanding receivership fees and expenses previously approved by the Court shall be paid from the \$100,000 in funds held by the Receiver;		
5	(4)	the parties shall meet and confer with respect to any additional receivership fees and expenses, and such fees and expenses shall be submitted for Court approval	
6		only if the parties cannot agree with respect to payment of such fees and expenses;	
7	(5)	the Receiver's motion for contempt is denied;
