20	The County of Monterey, a non-party to this ac	tion, seeks an extension of the receivership	
21	through September 30, 2011. Prior to filing, the County circulated the instant motion to Plaintiff,		
22	Defendant, and the Receiver. Plaintiff has not responded, Defendant opposes extension of the		
23	receivership, and the Receiver has indicated that he has no comment with respect to the motion.		
24	The County asserts that the requested extension of the receivership is necessary: (1) to		
25	provide the Receiver with additional time to prepare a final accounting for the San Jerardo Water		
26	System; (2) for County and Receiver to submit necessary documentation for reimbursement to		
27	state and federal grant funding agencies; and (3) to resolve remaining San Jerardo Water System		
28	issues.		

1	As Defendant points out, it is unclear from the County's papers why the Receiver would		
2	need six more months to prepare a final accounting; why it would be necessary to the		
3	receivership to remain in place in order for documentation to be submitted to state and federal		
4	grant funding agencies; and what other issues remain with respect to the San Jerardo Water		
5	System. Accordingly, the Court will extend the receivership for one month and solicit letter		
6	briefs addressing these issues so that it may make a reasoned decision with respect to the		
7	County's request to extend the receivership through September 30, 2011.		
8	ORDER		
9	(1)	The receivership is HEREBY EXTENDED through April 30, 2011.	
10	(2)	On or before April 15, 2011, the County, the Receiver, and Plaintiff shall file	
11		letter briefs addressing the issues raised above. On or before April 22, 2011,	
12		Defendant shall file a letter brief in response. The letter briefs shall not exceed	
13		five pages.	
14	(3)	The matter thereafter will be submitted without oral argument.
