



1 As Defendant points out, it is unclear from the County's papers why the Receiver would  
2 need six more months to prepare a final accounting; why it would be necessary to the  
3 receivership to remain in place in order for documentation to be submitted to state and federal  
4 grant funding agencies; and what other issues remain with respect to the San Jerardo Water  
5 System. Accordingly, the Court will extend the receivership for one month and solicit letter  
6 briefs addressing these issues so that it may make a reasoned decision with respect to the  
7 County's request to extend the receivership through September 30, 2011.

8 **ORDER**

- 9 (1) The receivership is HEREBY EXTENDED through April 30, 2011.
- 10 (2) On or before April 15, 2011, the County, the Receiver, and Plaintiff shall file  
11 letter briefs addressing the issues raised above. On or before April 22, 2011,  
12 Defendant shall file a letter brief in response. The letter briefs shall not exceed  
13 five pages.
- 14 (3) The matter thereafter will be submitted without oral argument.
