1 WHEREAS, on March 19, 2003, plaintiffs filed *Veliz v. Cintas Corporation*, Case No. C-03-  
2 1180-SBA, in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California (“*Veliz*  
3 Action”) against defendants (collectively “Cintas”), alleging that Cintas had failed to pay all  
4 overtime wages due under the FLSA and certain state laws and deprived them of certain benefits  
5 protected by ERISA;

6 WHEREAS, *Veliz* Action plaintiffs Joe D. Ashcraft (“Ashcraft”), Jason Barnes (“Barnes”),  
7 and Dennis F. Knudsen (“Knudsen”), have now determined to dismiss with prejudice their respective  
8 causes of action and/or claims against Cintas as set out in the *Veliz* Action;

9 NOW THEREFORE, the parties, through their respective counsel of record, hereby stipulate:

10 1. Plaintiffs Ashcraft, Barnes, and Knudsen hereby withdraw and dismiss with  
11 prejudice, all causes of action and claims made in *Veliz v. Cintas Corporation*, N.D. Cal., Case No.  
12 C-03-1180-RS.

13 2. Neither this stipulation nor the order of dismissal thereon shall constitute or imply  
14 any admission, concession or adjudication by any party regarding any claim raised in or by the *Veliz*  
15 Action.

16 3. This stipulation may be executed in counterparts and the executed counterparts may  
17 be exchanged electronically or by facsimile, but all such counterparts taken together shall constitute  
18 but one and the same stipulation.

19 4. Each party shall bear its own costs, attorneys’ fees and litigation expenses related  
20 solely to the prosecution and defense of the withdrawing plaintiffs’ claims in the *Veliz* Action.
