- 16 1. WHEREAS, this case was initially filed in 2003;

 25 case can be resolved without further litigation;
 26 7. WHEREAS, those conversations remain ongoing, no significant discovery has occurred,
 27 but a Case Management Conference is scheduled for April 26, 2013, a date which triggers meet and
