1	Defendant and counterclaimant Google Inc.'s ("Google") Motion to Preclude and/or
2	Compel came for hearing before this Court on June 22, 2005.
3	After consideration of the papers filed in connection with the motion, the argument of
4	counsel, and all other matters presented to the Court, and good cause appearing therefore,
5	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: Google's motion is GRANTED.
6	Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. Proc 37(c), Digital Envoy shall not offer at trial or any future
7	proceeding in this case, evidence in support of the contentions specified in Google Interrogatory
8	Nos. 8-10, 19;
9	OR
10	Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. Proc 37(c), Digital Envoy shall provide complete and
11	substantive further responses, without objection, to Google Interrogatory Nos. 8-10 and within
12	ten days of the date of this Order, and shall be barred from offering at trial or any future
13	proceeding in this case, any evidence not provided in those further responses.
14	AND
15	Digital Envoy shall provide further responses, without objection, to Google's Requests
16	for Admission Nos. 3-4, and, if applicable, a complete and substantive further response, without
17	objection, to Google Interrogatory No. 20, both within ten days of the date of this Order.
