Plaintiff 18 claims that defendants discriminated against him based on his sexual orientation, in violation of 19 the Equal Protection Clause. Defendants have filed a motion for summary judgment. Plaintiff 20 has filed an opposition, and defendants have filed their reply. 21 However, prior to filing his opposition, plaintiff filed an objection to the defendants' 22 motion for summary judgment. In that objection, plaintiff alleged that he never received the 23 court's January 27, 2011 order of service. In light of plaintiff's assertion, and a general chrono 24 submitted by plaintiff from a correctional officer (Opp. at 6) stating that no mail from the 25 Northern District Court was received for plaintiff from January 25, 2011 through April 27, 2011, 26 the court will send plaintiff another copy of the January 27, 2011 order of service. 27 Further, the court sua sponte grants plaintiff thirty (30) days from the filing date of this 28 Order Granting Extension of Time to File Supplemental Opposition G:\PRO-SE\SJ.Rmw\CR old\CR.04\Smith793misc.wpd
