Baar moved to quash 21 22 the subpoena or alternatively for a protective order, and for sanctions against Plaintiff. On March 11, 2011, Magistrate Judge Paul Grewal issued an order denying the motion to quash, granting in 23 part the alternative motion for a protective order, and denying the motion for sanctions. 1	Judge Grewal's ruling is not "clearly erroneous or contrary to law." See Fed. R. Civ. P.
2	72(a). As Judge Grewal noted in footnote 13 of his order, Baar's motion to quash was denied.
3	Baar's alternative motion for a protective order was granted only in part. Under these
4	circumstances, it was well within Judge Grewal's discretion to deny Baar's motion for sanctions.
5	Accordingly, the motion for relief will be DENIED.
6	IT IS SO ORDERED.
