APPLICATION TO STAY MOTIONS FOR
ATTORNEYS FEES OR ADJUST BRIEFING
SCHEDULE

Two days before the scheduled hearing on defendants' motions for attorneys' fees, and more than two months after the motions were filed, Plaintiff Neil B. Goldberg moves ex parte for an order staying the motions pending his appeal of the court's grant of summary judgment and entry of final judgment in favor of defendants or providing a new briefing schedule to give Goldberg an opportunity to oppose the motions.
