1 Defendant Google Inc.'s ("Google") Administrative Motion for Leave to File a  
2 Document Under Seal Pursuant To Civ. L.R. 79-5, in connection with the parties' Joint  
3 Statement of Undisputed Facts, was heard before this Court on June 21, 2007, at 10:00 a.m.  
4 Upon consideration of this Motion and the supporting Declaration of M. Christopher Jhang filed  
5 therewith, the Court finds there is good cause to grant Google's request to file the following  
6 documents under seal:

7 **1. JOINT STATEMENT OF UNDISPUTED FACTS.**

8 GOOD CAUSE having been shown, the Court finds that:

9 (1) The parties possess overriding confidentiality interests that overcome the right of  
10 public access to the record in the following documents;

11 (2) The parties' overriding confidentiality interests support sealing the record;

12 (3) A substantial probability exists that the parties' overriding confidentiality interests  
13 will be prejudiced if the record is not sealed;

14 (4) The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and

15 (5) No less restrictive means exist to achieve this overriding interest.

16 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Google's Administrative Motion for Leave to File  
17 a Document Under Seal is GRANTED.
