Now, therefore, Plaintiff and all Defendants hereby stipulate and agree to the following revised schedule for class certification, subject to the Court's approval:

- 1. The hearing on Plaintiffs Motion for Class Certification shall be continued to December 3, 2010;
- 2. Plaintiff shall file his reply to Defendants' response to the Motion for Class Certification on or before November 24, 2010;
