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On May 19, 2010, Defendant Ernst & Young LLP ("Defendant") filed an administrative motion to apply this Court's ruling with respect to Defendant's motion for summary judgment as to Plaintiff Michelle Richards to the claims of Plaintiffs Joseph Landon and Sarah Fernandez ("Plaintiffs") as well, thereby dismissing their claims for injunctive relief with prejudice and dismissing their meal and rest break claims without prejudice.
