In a prior order, the Court granted the requests of the Associated Press, the San Jose 15 Mercury News, and the Stockton Record to attend the hearing as pool reporters, and solicited 16 requests from other reporters who wished to attend in the event that one or two additional pool 17 18 reporters could be accommodated. The Court noted that it would give priority to reporters who have been covering this litigation regularly and who are familiar with the legal and factual issues 19 in the litigation. 20 The Court has received fifteen additional requests. Unfortunately, in light of the 21 logistical limitations at the prison, it can grant only two.
