ORDER REGARDING MEDIA
REQUESTS

14 A partial evidentiary hearing at San Quentin State Prison is scheduled for February 8,
15 2011. In a prior order, the Court granted the requests of the Associated Press, the San Jose
16 Mercury News, and the Stockton Record to attend the hearing as pool reporters, and solicited
17 requests from other reporters who wished to attend in the event that one or two additional pool
18 reporters could be accommodated. The Court noted that it would give priority to reporters who
19 have been covering this litigation regularly and who are familiar with the legal and factual issues
20 in the litigation.

21 The Court has received fifteen additional requests. Unfortunately, in light of the
22 logistical limitations at the prison, it can grant only two. Good cause appearing therefor, the
23 Court will grant the requests of the Los Angeles Times and Southern California Public Radio.
24 The Court regrets that it must decline the remaining requests.
