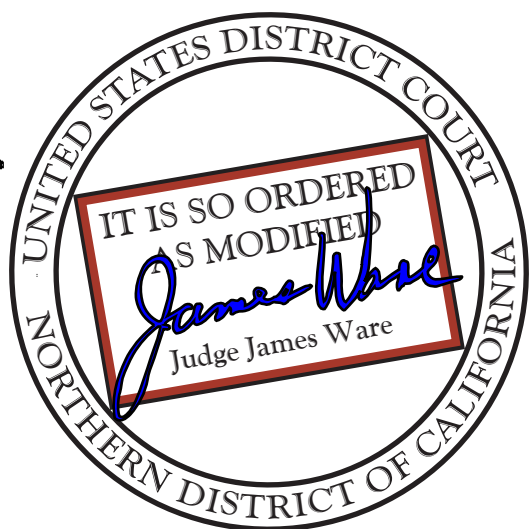

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT



24 Now comes the Court, being fully advised of the agreement of the parties regarding possible
 25 settlement in this matter and pursuant to the request of the parties to hold in abeyance the current
 26 scheduling deadlines set out in the Court's prior order dated August 11, 2009, the Court orders that
 27 the remaining deadlines be abated and extended for 2 weeks. During this time, the parties will report

1 the status of the settlement discussions to the Court so that further appropriate orders may be
2 entered.

3 The parties are currently set for a Preliminary Pretrial Conference for November 16, 2009.
4 The Court VACATES the Pretrial conference but sets a Status Conference re: Settlement for
5 the same day. Thus, while all pretrial deadlines are abated, the parties shall appear on
6 **November 16, 2009 at 10 a.m.** for a Status Conference. On or before **November 6, 2009**, the
7 parties shall file a Joint Status Statement. The Statement shall update the Court on the status of
8 the parties' settlement efforts.
