1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that James Bader, Anthony Kanka, and Levearl Snider shall be  
2 joined as plaintiffs in the above-captioned case for the following causes of action only: (a) failure to  
3 pay overtime under the Federal Labor Standards Act ("FLSA") and (b) failure to pay the minimum  
4 wage under the FLSA.

5 IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Court finds that the Confidential Settlement  
6 Agreements (which have been filed under seal), and the terms and conditions contained therein, are  
7 fair, adequate, and reasonable and were agreed to by all parties. Therefore, the Court hereby  
8 APPROVES the settlement on the terms and conditions provided in the Confidential Settlement  
9 Agreements.
