WHEREAS, for the reasons discussed above and to facilitate the Mediation, justification and good cause exists for (1) vacating the December 9, 2011 Further Case Management Conference and motion to dismiss hearing date, (2) continuing until February 17, 2012 the date by which any defendant must file a motion to dismiss Plaintiffs' Supplemental Second Amended Consolidated Verified Shareholder Derivative Complaint ("SSAC") or other responsive pleading, and (3) deferring a ruling on the parties' letter briefs regarding the production of documents until a ruling is requested by any party.

NOW THEREFORE, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COURT, THE PARTIES HEREBY STIPULATE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) The Further Case Management Conference and motion to dismiss hearing scheduled for December 9, 2011 are vacated;
