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

23 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1), by and among all  
24 remaining parties to this action – (1) Plaintiffs and Counter-Defendants Grateful Dead Productions;  
25 Cadestansa LLC, a limited liability company on behalf of Carlos Santana; Jimmy Page; Robert Plant;  
26 John Paul Jones; Fantality Corp.; Sony BMG Music Entertainment; BMG Music; and Arista Records;  
27 (2) Counter-Defendants Warner Music Group Corp.; Rhino Entertainment Company; and Bravado  
28 International Group, Inc.; and (3) Defendants and Counterclaimants William E. Sagan; Norton LLC;

1 and Bill Graham Archives LLC d/b/a Wolfgang's Vault (collectively, the "Defendants-  
2 Counterclaimants")– through their respective counsel, as follows:

3 1. The Plaintiffs' Dismissal Of Claims Without Prejudice. All remaining claims being  
4 asserted by the Plaintiffs are hereby dismissed *without prejudice*, including but not limited to the  
5 Plaintiffs' Fifth, Sixth, Tenth, Eleventh, Twelfth, Thirteenth, Fourteenth, Fifteenth, Sixteenth,  
6 Seventeenth, and Eighteenth Causes of Action of the Second Amended Complaint.

7 2. The Defendants-Counterclaimants' Dismissal Of Counterclaims Without Prejudice.  
8 All remaining counterclaims being asserted by the Defendants-Counterclaimants are hereby  
9 dismissed *without prejudice*, including but not limited to the Defendants-Counterclaimants' First,  
10 Second, Third, Fourth, Seventh, Eighth, Tenth, and (to the extent necessary) Eleventh  
11 Counterclaims.<sup>1</sup>

12 3. Each Party To Bear Its Own Costs And Expenses. With respect to each and every  
13 claim and counterclaim being dismissed by the Stipulation, each party shall bear his or its own costs  
14 and expenses, including attorneys' fees.

15 4. Dismissal Of Entire Action. By virtue of this Stipulation, no claims or counterclaims  
16 remain pending, and the above-captioned action is hereby dismissed. All claims and counterclaims  
17 are dismissed *without prejudice* as set forth above.
