



2 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, no later than December 16, 2008, any party that objects to  
3 the court conducting an *in camera* review of the documents shall file a brief setting forth the basis  
4 for the objection. As discussed in this court's order of this same date on Defendants' motion to  
5 compel, Plaintiff has waived her right to privacy with respect to her mental health records to the  
6 extent her mental health information is relevant to this lawsuit. Because the records submitted by  
7 San Mateo for in camera review may include records outside the scope of Plaintiff's waiver, it  
8 appears *in camera* review is warranted in order to determine which of the records should be  
9 disclosed to Defendants.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if Plaintiff files an objection to this order by December 23,  
11 2008,<sup>3</sup> the *in camera* review will automatically be stayed pending District Judge Fogel's ruling on  
12 Plaintiff's objection.
