**CLERK'S NOTICE RE: FAILURE
TO FILE ELECTRONICALLY
AND/OR REGISTER AS AN E-
FILER**

10 On April 5, 2007, counsel for Plaintiff filed Exhibit A to Declaration of I Neel Chatterjee (#46)
11 manually, on paper. This case has been designated for electronic filing, pursuant to Local Rule 5-4 and
12 General Order 45.

13 The above mentioned paper document has been filed and docketed. However, General Order 45
14 provides at Section III that cases assigned to judges who participate in the e-filing program "shall be
15 presumptively designated" as e-filing cases. Therefore, counsel for Plaintiff should submit Exhibit A
16 to Declaration of I Neel Chatterjee (46), in PDF format within 10 days, as an attachment in an *e-mail*
17 message directed to the judges chamber's "PDF" email box listed at <http://ecf.cand.uscourts.gov>. (Click
18 on the **Judges** button and follow the procedure listed there). Do *not* e-file a document which has been
19 previously filed on paper, as is the case with the above mentioned filing. All subsequent papers should
20 be e-filed.

21 Further, General Order 45 provides at Section IV (A) that "Each attorney of record is obligated to
22 become an ECF User and be assigned a user ID and password for access to the system upon designation
23 of the action as being subject to ECF." Counsel in this case who have not yet registered as ECF Users
24 must do so immediately. Forms and instructions for registering can be found on the Court's Web site
25 at ecf.cand.uscourts.gov.
