1 The Court after reviewing the Stipulated Request for Order Continuing Trial Date and Other
2 Deadlines in Further Case Management Scheduling Order, and for good cause appearing, makes the
3 following order:

4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the trial date in this matter shall be continued from
5 December 15, 2009 to March 15, 2010.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadlines set forth in the Further Case Management
7 Scheduling Order issued March 19, 2009 and modified by Court Order entered May 29, 2009 shall
8 be extended as follows:

- 9 a. Completion of non-expert discovery to occur on or before November 3, 2009;
- 10 b. On or before December 15, 2009, plaintiff shall disclose expert testimony and
11 reports in accordance with Rule 26(a)(2), F.R.Civ.P.;
- 12 c. On or before December 30, 2009, defendant shall disclose expert testimony
13 and reports in accordance with Rule 26(a)(2), F.R.Civ.P.;
- 14 d. On or before January 15, 2010, all discovery of expert witnesses pursuant to
15 Rule 26(a)(4), F.R.Civ.P. shall be completed;
- 16 e. All pretrial motions shall be heard on or before January 29, 2010;
- 17 f. Counsel for the parties shall meet and confer to discuss the preparation of a
18 joint pretrial statement and shall file a file a Joint Pretrial Statement on or
19 before February 23, 2010;
- 20 g. The final pretrial conference will be held on March 3, 2010, at 2:30 p.m., or
21 on a date thereafter that is convenient to the Court;
- 22 h. Jury trial shall commence on March 15, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., or on a date
23 thereafter that is convenient to the Court.
