17 Steven E. Rindner, a defendant in the case captioned *Securities and Exchange*
 18 *Commission v. Kelly et al.*, Civ. No. 08 cv 4612 (S.D.N.Y.) (hereinafter "Related Case"),
 19 currently pending in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, has
 20 requested the discovery of documents and transcripts from Securities and Exchange Commission
 21 ("SEC"), the plaintiff in that case and the instant case. Some of the materials requested by Mr.
 22 Rindner fall under the confidentiality provision of the Joint Case Management Statement of
 23 September 28, 2007. After discussions among counsel for Mr. Rindner and the parties in the
 24 above-captioned litigation, it is agreed as follows:

25 (1) Pursuant to Mr. Rindner's Third Request for the Production of Documents and
 26 Rule 45 Subpoena dated May 26, 2009, as set forth in Exhibit A (attached hereto), the SEC has
 27 agreed to produce responsive discovery requests/responses and deposition testimony transcripts

1 in the *SEC v. Leslie* case (hereinafter, "Protected Documents"). However, the SEC will not
2 produce any responsive discovery requests/responses or portions of deposition testimony
3 transcripts which relate to confidential financial information of the defendants in the *SEC v.*
4 *Leslie* case; the defendants in *SEC v. Leslie* will identify such confidential documents for the
5 SEC, and provide to the SEC appropriately redacted deposition transcripts for production, within
6 14 (fourteen) days of the entry of this order.

7 (2) Access to Protected Documents shall be restricted to persons authorized by this
8 Order, namely Mr. Rindner, Joseph E. Ripp, John Michael Kelly and Mark Wovsaniker (the
9 defendants in the Related Case, collectively, the "Related Case Defendants"), and the SEC in the
10 Related Case; their attorneys of record; and attorneys, paralegals, investigators, experts, and
11 secretaries or other individuals employed by, or performing work on behalf of, the attorneys of
12 record for the Related Case Defendants and the SEC in the Related Case.

13 (3) The following restrictions are placed on the Related Case Defendants and the
14 other above-designated individuals, unless and until further ordered by the Court. The
15 Related Case Defendants and the other individuals designated above shall not:

- 16 a. make copies for, or allow copies of any kind to be made by, any other
17 person of Protected Documents;
- 18 b. allow any other person to read Protected Documents;
- 19 c. communicate the substance of the information in Protected Documents to
20 anyone else, other than to non-party witnesses (or their attorneys) whom
21 the parties are preparing for deposition or trial testimony in the Related
22 Case;
- 23 d. use, directly or indirectly, Protected Documents, or any of the information
24 contained in Protected Document, for any purpose other than preparing for
25 the trial in the litigation of the Related Case;
- 26 e. use any deposition or trial testimony generated in the Related Case that
27 discloses, refers to, or was generated by information contained in
28

1 Protected Documents for any purpose other than preparing for the trial in
2 the Related Case.

3 (4) The scope of this Order is intended to confine the use of Protected Documents
4 and the information contained in Protected Documents and the information contained in
5 Protected Documents to the litigation in the Related Case. Any other use of Protected
6 Documents and the information contained in Protected Documents would violate this Order.
7

8 (5) The Related Case Defendants' attorneys shall inform any person to whom
9 disclosure shall be made pursuant to this Order of the existence and terms of this Order. All
10 individuals receiving any Protected Documents shall agree with the terms of this Order and
11 shall not otherwise disclose Protected Documents to the public or any other person or entity
12 other than pursuant to the terms of this Order, and shall acknowledge their agreement to
13 comply with the provisions of this Order by signing a copy of the attached acknowledgement
14 form. The disclosing party will retain copies of signed acknowledgment forms until such time
15 as the Related Case, including all appeals, is concluded.
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18 (6) Nothing in this Order shall restrict the use or introduction of Protected
19 Documents as evidence or exhibits by the Related Case Defendants' attorneys or the SEC's
20 attorneys during any deposition or trial in the Related Case.
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22 (7) Upon conclusion of the Related Case, the Related Case Defendants'
23 attorneys shall return to counsel for the SEC, or destroy and certify to counsel for the SEC
24 the destruction of, all Protected Documents within a reasonable period of time, not to
25 exceed 30 days after the last appeal in the Related Case is final.
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27 (8) This Order does not constitute any ruling on the question of whether any
28 particular document or category of information is properly discoverable and does not

1 constitute any ruling on any potential objection to the discoverability, relevance, or
2 admissibility of any Protected Documents.

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4 (9) Any and all disputes related to this Consent Order shall be resolved in the
5 United States District Court for the Northern District of California.






