21 2011, the Court orders as follows:

22 Defendants Sallaberry and Lonchar may file motions for summary judgment on or before
23 August 19, 2011. Plaintiff need not respond to the motions unless and until directed to do so by
24 the Court. On or before September 30, 2011, the parties shall update the Court in writing with
25 respect to the status of any settlement discussions. After that date the Court will decide whether
26 it will consider the motions for summary judgment on the merits and, if appropriate, will solicit
27 briefing and set a hearing date.
