BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF NATURE OF ACTION AND RESULT BELOW:

Plaintiff Louis Vuitton Malletier, S.A. owns valuable copyrights and trademarks that were used to display, market, distribute and sell counterfeit merchandise on numerous websites hosted by Defendants despite notice. A jury found all Defendants liable for contributory copyright and trademark infringement and awarded \$32.4M in damages. An injunction was entered. On Defendants' post-trial motions, the trial court set aside the verdict as to Defendant Managed Solutions Group, Inc.


