Neither interim lead counsel nor any other party has opposed the motion to shorten time. Civil L.R. 6-3 requires the moving party to "identif[y] the substantial harm or prejudice that would occur if the Court did not change the time."

Having reviewed the papers and considered the arguments of counsel, plaintiffs' motion is granted.<sup>1</sup> The hearing shall be held on March 2, 2010 at 10AM in Courtroom 5. Any oppositions shall be filed no later than February 19, 2010 and replies, if any, shall be filed no later than February 24, 2010.
