**ORDER**

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that APIO, INC. ("Apio"), through its counsel  
2 of record, Sheldon Mak Rose & Anderson, their support staffs and vendors  
3 assisting Apio's counsel, permission to bring into the Federal Courthouse in San  
4 Jose, California, located at 280 South 1st Street. San Jose. CA, and set up in the  
5 courtroom of the Honorable Jeremy Fogel, on Monday morning, September 22,  
6 2008, prior to the *Markman* hearing that day (or on Friday, September 19, 2008,  
7 after conclusion of Court business that day), certain equipment and materials as  
8 demonstrative exhibits and for purposes of facilitating illustrative exhibits for that  
9 hearing. The demonstrative equipment and materials may include:

- 10 • 2 laptop computers;
- 11 • 1 wireless clicker with built-in laser pointer;
- 12 • Miscellaneous accessory cables, power strips, power supplies and  
13 cases;
- 14 • 1 mechanical pointer;
- 15 • 6 or fewer exemplary plastic food trays, some containing vegetables  
16 and dip.

17 Court staff, including assistant U.S. Marshals on duty at the time, are  
18 directed to allow to take such steps as reasonably necessary to facilitate the  
19 foregoing activity. Apio is permitted to bring the materials into the Courtroom  
20 prior to and on September 22, 2008, and may remove the materials following the  
21 conclusion of the September 22, 2008 hearing.
