Dear Lisa:


I received your letter of today's date. There is no dispute that, at a minimum, IKON has acknowledged that it should not have delivered the documents to you and documents were erroneously produced by IKON to you through no fault of our own. You have refused us both leaving me with no choice but to seek relief from the Court.

Your continued possession of these documents is a misappropriation, which will not serve as the basis for a negotiation. You and I were in the middle of negotiations when IKON improperly released the documents, apparently at your request. I am prepared to conclude those negotiations this week, but only after you have returned the materials and destroyed the copy you have made.

I conclude by noting that your letter regarding our conversations on Friday, December 19, is incomplete, inaccurate, and therefore misleading. For example, I was explicit in my conversation with you that The Regents had not completed its analysis regarding compliance under HIPAA. It was for this reason, in addition to the need to conduct quality control on the IKON job, that we needed to review any documents before authorizing release.

Since you remain steadfast in your refusal to return the documents, we will proceed with our *ex parte* request.
