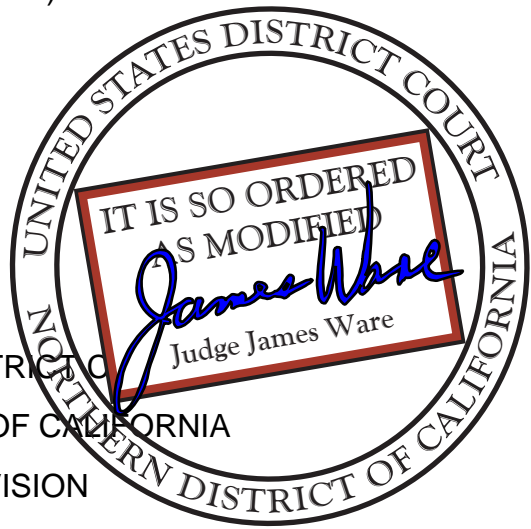

**JOINT STATUS STATEMENT
 ORDER CONTINUING STATUS
 CONFERENCES**

20 Pursuant to the Court's August 27, 2009 Order Vacating Preliminary Pretrial
 21 Conference, the parties hereby submit the following Joint Status Statement. As this Court is
 22 aware, this is a Fair Labor and Standards Act case in which the Plaintiffs are asserting,
 23 based on several different theories, that Defendant City of San Jose has not paid Plaintiff
 24 firefighters overtime consistent with the Fair Labor and Standards Act for the last several
 25 years. The City denies these allegations.

26 After further extensive efforts to resolve the remaining differences between the
 27 parties, the parties now believe they have reached a settlement agreement in principle,
 28 subject to proper authorization. Over the next several weeks, the parties will endeavor to

1 finalize in writing the specific terms of the settlement, obtain proper authorization, and agree
2 to a Stipulated Judgment, as is mandated in FLSA cases.

3 In light of the current status of this case, the parties jointly request a 75 day
4 continuance of the Status Conference to allow them an opportunity to take the necessary
5 steps to have this matter finalized. Should a Stipulated Judgment be filed by the parties and
6 approved by the Court prior to the continued Status Conference, the parties ask that this
7 matter be dismissed at that time and that the Status Conference be taken off calendar.

25 file a Joint Status Statement. If Stipulate Dismissals are filed on January 22, 2010, the Status
26 Conference will be vacated.
