**STIPULATION AND ~~PROPOSED~~
 ORDER TO EXTEND TIME FOR
 PLAINTIFFS' TO FILE MOTION FOR
 PROTECTIVE ORDER REGARDING
 DESIGNATION OF CONSULTANT
 UNDER THE STIPULATED
 PROTECTIVE ORDER**

1 WHEREAS, Plaintiffs Acer, Inc., Acer America Corporation, and Gateway, Inc. (collectively,
2 “Plaintiffs” or “Acer”) and Defendants Technology Properties Limited, Patriot Scientific
3 Corporation, and Alliacense Limited (collectively, “TPL”) entered into a Stipulated Protective Order.
4 Dkt. No. 142.

5 WHEREAS, per Section 7.4 of the Stipulated Protective Order, on August 2, 2010, Acer filed
6 its timely objection to TPL’s request to disclose Plaintiffs’ “Highly Confidential – Attorneys’ Eyes
7 Only” information and items to Vojin Oklobdzija and their use of him as an expert/consultant. Dkt.
8 No. 172.

9 WHEREAS, counsel for TPL was not available to meet and confer with Acer within three (3)
10 court days as required by Section 7.4 of the Stipulated Protective Order.

11 WHEREAS, the parties agreed to meet and confer over the designation of Dr. Oklobdzija on
12 the earliest mutually convenient date, August 6, 2010, and therefore also agreed to extend the time for
13 Acer to file its motion for a protective order (if necessary) until August 16, 2010 after the parties
14 complete their meet and confer as required by Section 7.4(c) of the Protective Order.

15 WHEREAS, the parties further agreed that if the Court is available and willing to hear the
16 motion on shortened time, any motion for protective order filed by Acer should be briefed and heard
17 on the following schedule:

- 18 • TPL shall have seven (7) court days to file any opposition to a motion for protective
19 order;
- 20 • Acer shall have three (3) court days to file a reply brief; and
- 21 • The Motion for Protective Order shall be heard by the Court on September 7, 2010.

22 WHEREAS, the parties agree that should the Court set the hearing for a later date, the parties
23 will agree to modify and extend the foregoing briefing scheduled accordingly.

24 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED THAT:

- 25 1. The parties shall meet and confer on August 6, 2010 regarding their disputed over
26 TPL’s designation of Dr. Oklobdzija as an expert/consultant under the Stipulated Protective Order;
- 27 2. If the parties are unable to informally resolve their dispute over the designation of Dr.
28 Oklobdzija, Acer shall have up to and including August 16, 2010 file a motion for protective order;

1 3. TPL shall have up to and including seven (7) court days to file any opposition to a
2 motion for protective order filed by Acer (filed no later than August 25, 2010);

3 4. Acer shall have up to and including three (3) court days to file any reply to TPL's
4 opposition (filed no later than August 30, 2010);

5 5. Acer's motion shall be heard on September 7, 2010 during the Court's normal civil
6 discovery calendar, or at the earliest hearing date thereafter that is convenient for the Court; and

7 6. Should the Court set the hearing after September 7, 2010, the parties agree to modify
8 and extend the briefing schedule for the opposition and reply accordingly.
