


1 Plaintiff did not understand that he was required to submit evidence in response to the motions.
2 Under these circumstances, justice is best served by allowing Plaintiff, representing himself *pro se*, a
3 final opportunity to submit evidence from which a reasonable trier of fact could find in his favor. If
4 Plaintiff fails to submit such evidence, Defendants' motions for summary judgment will be granted
5 and judgment entered against Plaintiff.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in the event Plaintiff submits further evidence in
7 opposition to Defendants' motions for summary judgment, Defendants may file supplemental reply
8 papers no later than July 31, 2009. The motions will then be deemed submitted at that time.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the trial dates in this matter are VACATED. The court
10 will hold a trial setting conference at 2:00 p.m. on August 18, 2009.
